ROTARY AUCTION RESULTS

We had a very successful auction last week. Thanks to all the Rotarians who came out to help. However, from around noon to 5:30, there were only 2 Rotarians there to help Herbert Lee with the auction. It seems like everyone came in the morning and no one came in the afternoon. It put a very hard burden on the very few Rotarians who worked all afternoon especially since these Rotarian were there from 7:30 AM until 5:30 PM with no break. The total auction sales amounted to \$16,993.00. The club will receive **35% (25% Seller's fee + 10% Buyer's fee)** of this amount after expenses have been paid. Hopefully, we will have a final report next week. The **Food Booth** had sales of \$188.85 with expenses of \$73.75, which yielded a net profit of \$115.10. We will have another auction in a few weeks since we did not get to the household items. We need for some Rotarians to sign up to help out in the afternoon for this next auction. We will have separate sign-up sheets: one for the **Auction** and one for the **Food Booth**.
