## TRUE-FALSE QUIZ

The answers to the quiz are:

- Woodstock was held at Woodstock, NY in 1969. (FALSE. It was scheduled for Woodstock but it took place in Bethel, New York, 45 miles southwest of Woodstock.)
- Saint Patrick was born in Ireland. (False. Saint Patrick was born in Britain in 389 C.E.)
- Illinois is west of the Mississippi River. TRUE. The river changed its course in the flood of 1881 leaving a piece of Southwest Illinois west of the Mississippi.)
- The US Constitution requires Presidents be born in US. (FALSE. The U.S. became in existence on July 4, 1776, no natural born citizen could be elected president until July 4, 1811; he would then be 35 years old. Constitution wasn't adopted until July 21, 1788)
- The Emancipation Proclamation freed slaves in 1863. (FALSE. The Proclamation appeared to be a crusade against slavery. It did not free any slaves in the Union only slaves in areas of Confederate control)
- The official US flag at one time had 15 stripes. (TRUE. After the 14<sup>th</sup> state, Vermont, and the 15<sup>th</sup> state, Kentucky joined, 2 more stripes were added to the 15. When 5 more states joined, Congress reverted back to a standard 13 stripes in 1818)
- In human reproduction, one sperm cannot fertilize an egg. (TRUE. Hundreds of millions of sperm are needed to fertilize a human egg. Each sperm secretes an enzyme called hyaluronidase. Enormous amounts of hyaluronidase are required to dissolve the protective membrane around the unfertilized egg before one sperm can get through and fertilize it.
